At Zion Lutheran School, we take pride in our dedicated team of certified teachers, each holding qualifications in early childhood education or their respective teaching fields. Our educators are committed to providing a high-quality Christian education that aligns with both state standards and the principles of the Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod (LCMS).

As an accredited school, Zion Lutheran adheres to rigorous academic standards, ensuring that our students receive an education that is both spiritually enriching and academically strong. We strive to foster a learning environment where students can grow in faith, knowledge, and character under the guidance of our highly trained and compassionate staff.

Health & Safety Initiatives

At Zion Lutheran School, the safety and well-being of our children is our top priority. We are committed to providing a secure, healthy, and nurturing environment where children can learn and grow. we recognize that a well-trained staff is essential to providing a safe, supportive, and enriching environment for children.

Our teachers and staff members undergo thorough training in key areas, including child development, safety protocols, first aid, and CPR. We provide regular professional development opportunities to ensure that staff remain informed about the latest best practices in early childhood education, health, and safety.

Additionally, staff receive ongoing training in emergency response procedures, conflict resolution, child abuse prevention, and infection control. We believe in fostering a culture of continuous learning, where staff are equipped with the knowledge and skills to handle a variety of situations and respond to the needs of each child. By prioritizing staff training, we ensure that every child in our care is supported, safe, and provided with the highest standard of care.

Drop-off & Pick-up Procedures:

As mentioned, and stated above, the safety and security of your child are our top priorities. To ensure a smooth and secure arrival and departure process, we ask that all children be dropped off and picked up by an authorized adult.

During pickup we follow procedures to ensure that children are only released to authorized individuals. This system helps us create a secure environment while building trust and open communication with our families. If someone other than the usual pick-up person will be coming for your child, just let us know ahead of time, and we'll make the necessary arrangements. You will be able to provide us with your authorized persons during the registration process.

Parent Communication

We value strong communication with parents to support student success. We use multiple channels to keep families informed and engaged in their child's development.

Our **Student Information System (SIS)** provides parents with access to updates, progress reports, and direct communication with teachers. For immediate needs, parents can contact us directly via email or phone.

We also use the **Remind app** for real-time notifications about school events, closures, and reminders, ensuring timely updates are easily accessible.

Effective communication is key to our program's success. By leveraging these tools, we strengthen our partnership with families and ensure they stay informed and involved in their child's learning.

Registration Policy & Admission Priority

Zion Lutheran School is committed to providing a full-time Christian education in alignment with the teachings and practices of the Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod (LCMS). As a ministry of the LCMS, all candidates for admission must acknowledge our doctrine and values.

Zion Lutheran School is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization that welcomes students from both within our congregation and from the broader community. We accept students of all races, colors, nationalities, disabilities, and ethnic origins, ensuring equal access to all rights, privileges, programs, and activities offered by the school. We do not discriminate in the administration of educational policies, athletics, or other school-administered programs.

Parents must apply for each student annually. Admission is contingent upon the availability of an appropriate educational program that meets the needs of the student. While Zion Lutheran School does not have specialized facilities for students with significant learning differences, we assess each student on a case-by-case basis to determine the best

educational environment for success. We reserve the right to deny admission if we cannot adequately meet a student's educational needs.

Zion Lutheran School also reserves the right to evaluate students to determine their readiness for placement in the appropriate grade level.

It is the objective of Zion Lutheran School to provide full-time Christian education to as many children as possible. However, limitations of facilities and student needs dictate that a system of priorities is necessary. Students will be generally accepted in the following order:

- 1. Children in membership of Zion Lutheran Church.
- 2. Children already enrolled from the previous year or years prior and their siblings.
- 3. Children of community congregations that do not have a school.
- 4. Children of the community.

Age Requirements for Enrollment

- Preschoolers for the 3's class must be age 3 on or before August 1st.
- Preschoolers for the 4's class must be age 4 on or before August 1st.
- All Kindergarten children must be age 5 on or before August 1st.
- All children entering 1st grade must be age 6 on or before August 1st.
- Zion will not offer a waiver concerning set state dates as provided by the State of Indiana Department of Education.

Required Documents for Enrollment

- Completed Registration Form
- Copy of the Child's Birth Certificate, if not already on file.
- Current Immunization Records or Wavier, if not already on file.
- Registration Fee Payment (Cash or Check), due at registration enrollment.

Extended Care Options

We are pleased to offer an extended care program to support your family's needs before and after school. Our before and after-school care provides a safe, nurturing environment where children can relax, socialize, and participate in fun, engaging activities. Whether it's working on homework or creative play and projects, our extended care staff ensures each child is cared for with the same love and attention as during school hours. Our program offers flexible scheduling options, allowing you to choose the care that best fits your

family's routine. We look forward to welcoming your child into our extended care community!

Starting with the 2025-'26 school year, we are introducing a subscription-based extended care program. This flexible approach allows you to use the program as needed, without having to worry about the length of time your child stays during before or after school care. Whether it's for a short or extended period, you can customize your child's care to fit your family's schedule.

Please speak with our preschool director to sign up as these times and availability may be different depending on current enrollment.

- Students who are picked up past the times stated are subject to a late fee of \$1 per minute past the pickup time.
- Each student receives one (1) grace day per semester if they need to attend before or aftercare due to an exigent circumstance.
- Our family discount starts with the second student in the care program, offering a 10% discount. After the second student, there is no additional charge for any further children from the same family. For example, the maximum cost for a family with more than two kids in the program is \$570 per quarter for unlimited care.
- We do offer a 3% discount for extended care that is paid in advance in full for the school year. Payment for the entire school year is due before August 1. Please ask our director about this discounted payment.
